Recent months have been quite eventful for IXcellerate's technical department. During this time, we were able to significantly expand the engineering infrastructure of our campus: we commissioned a new energy center and increased the total power capacity to 26 MW.

Due to the new requirements and restrictions imposed by the COVID-19 crisis, our outstanding engineers have adopted a new work schedule, allowing them to safely stay on site for two-week shifts.

This tremendous effort resulted in a substantial boost to the technical side of our facilities: we set up and commissioned brand new transformer substations, power modules and diesel generators. On top of that, we ran tests on the adiabatic cooling system and set up new air conditioners to ensure the necessary level of cooling redundancy for our customers, who have also installed new equipment over this period.

And last but not least, we are wrapping up work on the preparation of the brand new office space for the employees and customers of IXcellerate, and we just can't wait to invite everyone over. See you then!
